Chapters should strive to become the strongest Saiyan warrior by planning and participating in a well-rounded program. Each achievement listed below earns that chapter an amount of Ki. Chapters can train to ascend through the different Super Saiyan levels as they earn varying amounts of Ki to redeem for different prizes at the end of the term. Chapters will advance to a new tier by gaining 750 Ki. **The Scribe of the chapter or the Master Councilors designate must make all submissions within 30 days of the activity*** (<https://forms.gle/Yd3a14jCs2TCJulg9>) There are limits on the number of times you can earn Ki from an activity. If submissions are made by someone who is not an active DeMolay, they will receive half of the Ki the achievement is valued at. Additional opportunities to earn Ki outside of those listed below will be made known throughout the term and are at the discretion of the State Council. This program will run from July 15th 2023 until May 15th 2024. Chapter prize choices must be submitted to the State Master Councilor by no later than May 31st, 2024.

TRAVELING DRAGON BALLS VISITATION

OFFICIAL RULES

Each chapter will be given a box containing all of the dragon balls with a marking on it from 1-7 stars. You will need to attend each of the different chapters to receive all 7. (Installations and social events will count)

1. Once a chapter collects all 7 Dragon balls they can redeem them for a “Wish from Shenron”. Wishes will be awarded at the next convenient date for your chapter. The Wish will be awarded on a predetermined wheel with a grand prize that can only be redeemed once.
 - i. The chapter will get a pizza and ice cream party hosted by the state officers
 - ii. A chapter movie outing to a movie of their choice
 - iii. A state traveling program banner(customized by the JOs)
 - iv. Chapter 7ft portable Basketball hoop
 - v. The state officers will plan and run a fundraiser for the chapter, and the chapter will keep the funds raised
 - vi. Grand prize will be kept a secret until a chapter receives it
2. In order to receive the Traveling Dragon ball, a chapter must visit a chapter they currently do not have a “Dragon ball” for, on their regularly scheduled meeting night with at least 2 members and 1 advisor.
3. The chapter “collecting” the Traveling Dragon balls must contact Bro. Zanthis Hunter via email at hunterzanthis24@gmail.com within 48 hours in order to receive credit with “Traveling Dragon ball collection” in the Subject field of the email and state what chapter they are from and what chapter they visited. Failure to do so may result in chapter not receiving credit.
4. After every meeting at which you gain a dragon ball an email must be sent within 48 hours to Bro. Zanthis Hunter @hunterzanthis24@gmail.com with “Traveling Dragon ball meeting” in the subject line and state the chapter they are from and the date on which they met. You also have to provide a picture with the dragonball and the other chapter. Failure to do so will result in no Ki being awarded to said chapter.
5. If more than one visiting chapter is present on a regularly scheduled meeting night, both of the chapters will receive the dragon ball.
6. Elected State Officers do not count towards the number of visiting chapter members. And only 1 Appointed will count

7. In the event of an update to contest rules, appropriate communication will be made to all chapters.
8. Every 2 months the Dragon ball that each chapter has will rotate.
9. At promoted events there will be Dragon balls that are desired and will be able to be attained by all

NOTE: It is common courtesy to notify any chapter before visiting to ensure that the proper dress code is followed. Visiting chapters should plan to arrive on time and stay throughout the entire meeting of the chapter visited.
